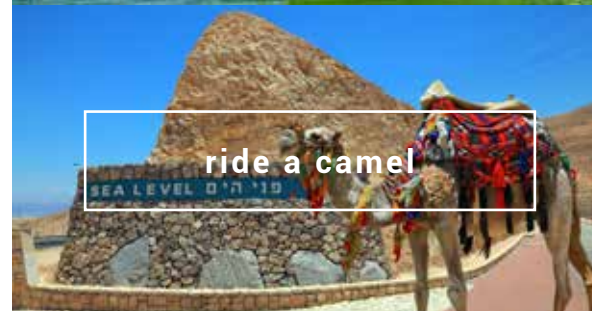

TOUR ITINERARY

DAY 1 - Saturday, March 10th

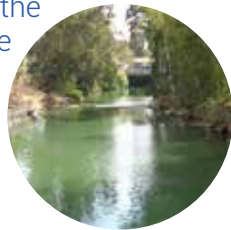
Check in at Air Canada (Flight AC 084)—Terminal 1 at least 3 hours prior to scheduled departure time (departure is at 5:00 PM).

DAY 2 - Sunday, March 11th

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport (9:15 AM) and be met by your friendly and knowledgeable Israeli guide. Continue to the Mediterranean coast stopping in the ancient port city of Jaffa, with its artist's quarter and traditional home of Simon the Tanner. Drive through the modern city of Tel Aviv en route to Caesarea where Paul was imprisoned and the first gentile was converted. Walk the excavated ruins including the theatre, hippodrome, King Herod's Palace and the impressive aqueduct located along the beach. *Overnight in Tiberias*

DAY 3 - Monday, March 12th

Begin with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, Sail from Tiberias to Nof Ginosar to see the "Jesus Boat" and learn of its discovery in the lake. Visit the synagogue during the time of Jesus recently excavated in Magdala. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes and Capernaum. Located here are the ruins of an ancient synagogue and the site of Peter's House. Visit Tabgha, traditional site of the multiplication of the fishes and loaves. See Bethsaida and Chorazin. End the day at Yardenit, the traditional Baptismal site at the Jordan River. You'll have the opportunity to be baptized or renew your vows. *Overnight in Tiberias*



DAY 4 - Tuesday, March 13th

Early departure from the Galilee via the Judean Mountains first stopping at the historic ruins of Beit Shean. Ascend to the Holy City stopping at

Mount Scopus for your first view of Jerusalem. Drive to the Mount of Olives for a view of the Old City Walls and the Kidron Valley and the traditional site of the tomb of Absalom. Drive (optional walk) down the Palm Sunday route to the Garden of Gethsemane and see up close the ancient olive trees. Visit the Church of All Nations. *Overnight in Jerusalem*

DAY 5 - Wednesday, March 14th

Drive to Bethlehem and spend time at Shepherd's Field. Proceed to Beit Jala and the **Lifegate Rehabilitation Centre*** to observe the efforts of Palestinian/German/Israeli professionals with diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of individuals with physical and mental issues. Visit Mount Zion, the traditional site of the Upper Room. Continue into the Old City. Visit the Jerusalem Archaeological Park (Southern Wall Excavations). Walk the same ancient steps Jesus used to enter and exit the Holy Temple. *Overnight in Jerusalem*



DAY 6 - Thursday, March 15th

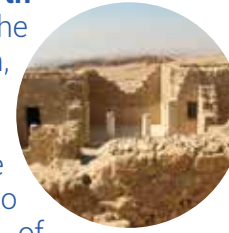
Visit the City of David for a sifting excursion of artifacts brought from the Temple Mount. Visit the Biblical Botanical Gardens at Neot Kedumim. Pay respect to the victims of the Holocaust at Yad Vashem, National Holocaust Memorial, the Museum, Children's Memorial and Avenue of the Righteous Gentiles. *Overnight in Jerusalem*

DAY 7 - Friday, March 16th

Visit the Western Wall, then explore the Western Wall Tunnels exiting near the Church of St Anne and Pool of Bethesda. Continue along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. End the day at the Garden Tomb with a special service next to the tomb itself. Enjoy a delicious Shabbat dinner this evening. *Overnight in Jerusalem*

DAY 8 - Saturday, March 17th

Depart for the region of the Dead Sea. Pass Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls encased in pottery jars and hidden in caves were discovered. Continue to Masada, last stronghold of the Zealots against the Romans. Stop at the beach to enjoy an opportunity to float in the mineral rich waters of the Dead Sea. *Overnight in Jerusalem*



DAY 9 - Sunday, March 18th

After breakfast transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for security and check in procedures, (*participants returning to Toronto*). Transfer to Eilat. On route, stop at Timna Park, with its Tabernacle replica. Arriving in Eilat, check in at your hotel. *Overnight in Eilat*

DAY 10 - Monday, March 19th

OPTIONAL day trip to Petra (additional \$390). Pay \$125 USD in person for visa, border taxes and fees and then cross into Jordan and be met by your Jordanian tour staff. Drive from Aqaba to Petra. Walk or horse ride to the Siq Canyon entrance to see the monumental Treasury—One of the wonders of the world. Stop at a local restaurant within Petra to enjoy a buffet lunch. Return drive to Eilat. *Overnight in Eilat*

DAY 11 - Tuesday, March 20th

Leisure morning to relax poolside or explore some of the sites or water activities on the Red Sea. Overland transfer with sites on route to the sea side city of Tel Aviv. *Overnight in Tel Aviv*

DAY 12 - Wednesday, March 21st

After breakfast transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for security and check in procedures on Air Canada (Flight AC 085) at 11:55 am, arriving in Toronto at 5:00 pm.
